

# 2019–2024 Nova Scotia School Project Briefs

## Annapolis Valley Regional Centre for Education

**West Hants Education Centre:** The alternative high school at West Hants Education Centre and the Windsor Adult High School are currently operating out of leased space. The alternative high school supports 23 students and the adult high school supports 32 students. A building will be purchased and renovated to serve as a permanent location for both schools.

## Conseil scolaire acadien provincial

**New CSAP high school in Dartmouth:** The former Newbridge Academy school was purchased and will be renovated to support CSAP students and families in HRM. The project was announced on September 30. The purchase and renovation will cost \$28.5 million. The school will serve about 900 students and will open its doors September 2020.

**Ecole acadienne de Truro:** The school will receive renovations that include the relocation of a parking lot and repositioning of a playground to ensure greater separation between students and vehicles.

**Ecole Par-en-Bas:** Located in Tusket, Yarmouth County, this school will receive a skilled trades facility to enhance learning opportunities, helping high school students make informed career pathway decisions.

## Chignecto-Central Regional Centre for Education

**North Nova Education Centre:** Located in New Glasgow, this school will receive a skilled trades facility to enhance learning opportunities, helping high school students make informed career pathway decisions.

## Halifax Regional Centre for Education

**Bedford Ravines High School Grades 9-12:** A new high school in Bedford will address student enrolment growth in the Bedford area. The school will be built on the site of the recently announced new P-9 school on Broad Street in Bedford Ravines. The site is large enough to accommodate both schools. The new high school will support about 1,200 students.

**Bicentennial School:** This pre-primary to Grade 9 school in Dartmouth is receiving repairs to its exterior brick work and classroom space. The school serves 330 students.

## South Shore Regional Centre for Education

**School Bus Garage:** A new school bus garage will be built at the existing Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal mechanical garage in Hebbville. This new bus garage will replace the existing school bus garage in Bridgewater.

**Liverpool Regional High School:** This school will receive two enhancements. The roof will be repaired to address water leaking in several areas of the building. A skilled trades facility to enhance learning opportunities, helping high school students make informed career pathway decisions, will also be built.

## Strait Regional Centre for Education

**East Antigonish Education Centre/Academy:** Located in Monastery, this school will receive a skilled trades facility to enhance learning opportunities, helping high school students make informed career pathway decisions.

**Cape Breton Highlands Education Centre/Academy:** Located in Terre Noire, this school will receive a skilled trades facility to enhance learning opportunities, helping high school students make informed career pathway decisions.
