Responsibilities:

Mathematics Support Specialist will have the responsibility of supporting provincial mathematics learning, grades 7 -12, with a particular focus on planning for a review of 7-12 curricula and supporting updates to mathematics pathways at high school grades. The Mathematics Support Specialist will be expected to work with the provincial math team and EECD colleagues to support the implementation of research -based, inclusive instructional strategies within an MTSS model, assessment and revision of curriculum, and the design and selection of learning resources. The specialist will work with the regional centres of education, CSAP, and department staff to support student success in mathematics. The mathematics support specialist will also work with key education partners such as teacher work groups, universities, colleges, other departments and agencies, professional associations and organizations, and advocacy groups to assist in informing the development of mathematics curriculum and supporting success for learners in mathematics.
