SUBJECT: Wage Increases for Early Childhood Educators

Nova Scotia committed to regular wage scale adjustments for Early Childhood Educators (ECEs) in Fall 2022 as part of our new ECE compensation framework.

We are pleased to advise that ECEs, Directors, Assistant Directors and Inclusion Coordinators employed in non-unionized, regulated and provincially funded child-care centres and family home agencies will receive a wage increase of 3% beginning April 1, 2023. An additional 0.5% wage increase will also be provided on March 31, 2024. These wage increases are consistent with overall public sector wage increases for management and non-bargaining unit staff of employers funded by the provincial government. These increases will be fully funded by the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development.

Wages of ECEs working in unionized centres are addressed through collective bargaining. This wage increase will apply to unionized centres with collective agreements or Memoranda of Agreements in place that include terms agreeing to these wage increases. Additional information to unionized centres will follow.

Though not in effect until April 1, 2023, we have provided these new wage scale rates on our website at www.childcarenovascotia.ca. The 2023-24 *Quality Investment Grant (QIG) Funding Agreement* and the accompanying *QIG Operator Guide* will be updated to reflect these new wage rates when they are sent to operators in February. Operators will continue to report hours worked via the QIG online claim form, which will automatically update to reflect these new wage rates for hours worked as of April 1, 2023.
