
Integrated French Certificate & IB Diploma/Certificate

French second language students can receive the Integrated French Certificate and the IB Diploma or IB Certificate by successfully completing the courses listed below in Options A or B.

Option A

- In Grade 10, two Integrated French or pre-IB courses offered in French, including one French language arts course and one other course taught in French from the approved offerings in the [Social Studies, Career Education or Arts Education sections of the Public School Programs](#).
- The IB French B higher level course
- One other approved grade 11 or 12 PSP Integrated French course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

OR

For IB Diploma students only, one of the following two options:

- The Theory of Knowledge essay, oral presentation and some TOK activities completed in French and the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) journal, essay and some CAS activities completed in French
- The Extended Essay completed in French

Option B

- In Grade 10, two Integrated French or pre-IB courses offered in French, including one French language arts course and one other course taught in French from the approved offerings in the [Social Studies, Career Education or Arts Education sections of the Public School Programs](#).
- The IB French B standard level course
- One IB standard level course from Group 3 (Individuals and Societies) or Group 6 (The Arts), offered in French

OR

For IB Diploma students only:

- One other grade 11 or 12 PSP Integrated French course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

AND

- One of the following three options:
 - The Theory of Knowledge essay, oral presentation and some TOK activities completed in French and the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) journal, essay and some CAS activities completed in French
 - The Extended Essay completed in French
 - Another grade 11 or 12 PSP Integrated French course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

For IB Certificate students:

- Two other approved grade 11 or 12 PSP Integrated French courses offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

The choice of courses that can be offered in the Integrated French Program will be as prescribed in the Public School Programs.
