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## French Immersion Certificate & IB Diploma/Certificate

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French second language students can receive the French Immersion Certificate and the IB Diploma or IB Certificate by successfully completing the courses listed below in Options A or B.

### Option A

- In Grade 10, four immersion or pre-IB courses offered in French, including one French language arts course.
- The IB French B higher level course.
- One IB standard level course from any group, such as Histoire, Géographie or Biologie, offered in French.

*OR*

For IB Diploma students only:

- One other grade 11 or 12 PSP French immersion course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

*AND*

One of the following three options:

- The Theory of Knowledge (TOK) essay, oral presentation and some TOK activities completed in French and the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) journal, essay and some CAS activities completed in French
- The Extended Essay completed in French
- Another grade 11 or 12 PSP French immersion course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year.

For IB Certificate students:

- Two other grade 11 or 12 PSP French immersion courses offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year.

### Option B

- In Grade 10, five immersion or pre-IB courses offered in French, including one French language arts course
- The IB French B higher level course
- One other grade 11 or 12 PSP French immersion course offered in the grade 11 or grade 12 year

*OR*

For IB Diploma students only, one of the following two options:

- The Theory of Knowledge (TOK) essay, oral presentation and some TOK activities completed in French and the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) journal, essay and some CAS activities completed in French
- The Extended Essay completed in French

The IB French B Standard Level course will not be recognized as a credit toward the French Immersion Certificate.
