

The above provides additional information about semesters, exams, reporting and parent-teacher conference dates for the 2022-2023 school year. Information about the academic school year was previously released in the the Policy and Information released in October 2021 (https://www.ednet.ns.ca/docs/schoolcalendar2022-23en.pdf). Please note that inservice days are established by Region/board.

The 2022–2023 academic school year is from August 1, 2022, to July 31, 2023.

The regular school term begins Thursday, September 1, 2022, and ends Friday, June 30, 2023.

The following holidays and vacation days are mandatory:

- Labour Day (September 5)
- Truth and Reconciliation Day (September 30)
- Thanksgiving Day (October 10)
- Remembrance Day (November 11)
- Holiday Break (December 21 to January 2 inclusive)

- Heritage Day (February 20)
- Spring Break (March 13 to March 17 inclusive)
- Good Friday (April 7)
- Easter Monday (April 10)
- Victoria Day (May 22)

General

All students are required to be present on the first instructional day of the school year. Where closing exercises are held for any school, they shall not be held prior to the evening of the 193rd day.

Of the 195 teaching days, no more than eight (8) days may be used for organizational and/or administrative purposes or for in-service training programs in accordance with the provisions of the Governor in Council Education Act Regulations, the Ministerial Education Act Regulations, and the Teachers' Provincial Agreement. In addition, two, one-half days may be used for purposes of parent-teacher meetings.

All teachers are required to be present on the days used for organizational and administrative purposes, in-service training programs, and parent-teacher meetings. Students are not required to be present on these days.

No more than nine (9) days in the school year may be allocated for examination purposes. Final examinations for grades 10–12 shall not begin prior to the five (5) days immediately preceding the end of the first semester and not prior to the 187th day of the school year.

A school, due to unusual circumstances, may wish to implement a school calendar that does not conform in all respects with the preceding provisions. Notwithstanding these provisions, the school may submit a request, through the education entity to the Regional Education Officer assigned to the education entity.
