

INS Functionality for High Schools - PowerTeacher Pro and the Student-Parent Portal

To align with the process outlined in the flowchart (page 3) of the “Classroom Assessment Due Date and Extension Procedures”, the PowerSchool Student/Parent Portal now displays the code **INS** (Insufficient evidence) as an «*In-Progress Mark*» whenever the teacher has flagged a student’s assignment SCORE as «*Missing*». This functionality applies to grades 1 to 12 and is only supported on the browser version of the PowerSchool Student/Parent Portal. It does not apply to the mobile application.

Callouts:

- If a SCORE is entered for an assignment, the Missing flag will NOT trigger INS.
- An Incomplete flag does NOT trigger an INS.
- If a Missing flag is accompanied by an Exempt flag, INS is NOT triggered.
- An Incomplete flag does NOT trigger an INS.
- Lynn is the only student who will have an INS as an In-Progress mark in the PowerSchool Student/Parent Portal.
- A Missing flag added as an outcome score will NOT trigger an INS.
- INS (Insufficient evidence) is only triggered as an In-Progress mark in the PowerSchool Student/Parent Portal when the assignment SCORE column is flagged with a Missing flag.
