Nova Scotia High School Transcript Guide (September 2023)

The Nova Scotia High School Transcripts (in PowerSchool) as well as the electronic transcript (MyTranscripts) have been updated. Changes were made to ensure better alignment with the Student Assessment Policy and the Inclusive Education Policy. All changes will only apply to students who are currently enrolled in school (September 2023).

For students who will graduate, complete studies, or leave school at any point after September 2023

- The transcript is an official record of courses the student has successfully completed at each grade level in high school.
- The Nova Scotia High School Transcript will only list the grade 10, 11 and 12 courses for which the student has received a passing grade (50% and above).
- The In-Progress Transcript will list the grade 10, 11 and 12 courses for which the student has received a passing grade (50% and above) and the student's currently enrolled courses. Currently enrolled courses are designated with IP and the student's most recently stored grade, whether passing or failing (e.g. ENGLISH 11 41/IP).

For students who graduated, completed studies, or left school prior to the end of June 2023

- The Nova Scotia High School Transcript will list all completed grade 10, 11, and 12 courses with a passing or a failing grade, as well as any courses assigned INS (insufficient evidence) as a final grade.
