# School Summary Assessment Results Report

School personnel have the ability to run a Summary results report for Provincial Student Assessments. The report displays the roll-up results for students who wrote a given assessment. The report summarizes information for those students who wrote the assessment at the school, not where students are currently enrolled. The report can be printed and/or exported to Excel.

1. From the start page of PowerSchool, under the section Reports, click on System Reports

2. Click on the Custom tab, click on the header Administrator to expand the section

3. Click on the report called, Assessment Reports – Summary Results

A. Select Assessment: select the report you wish to run from the drop down list: all the current NS Provincial Assessments are listed.

B. Select Assessment Year: From the drop down list, select the year in which the assessment you picked in option A, was written. You can run only one year at a time. Note that most assessments began in 2012-13. If you select an assessment from the drop down list, but select a combination of parameters that have no data, you will get a blank report. E.g. you select Mathematics in Grade 4 and the year 12- 13: the province did not administer Mathematics 4 in 12-13 so the resulting report will not display any data.

4. Once the parameters have been selected, click Submit to generate the report. The results can be viewed on the screen.

5. Click the Start Page or the word PowerSchool to return to PowerSchool.
