School Summary Assessment Results Report

User Guide

Revision Date: May 15, 2024 School personnel can run a Summary results report for Provincial Student Assessments. The report displays the roll-up results for students who wrote a given assessment. The report summarizes information for those students who wrote the assessment at the school, not where students are currently enrolled. The report can be printed and/or exported to Excel.

- 1. From the PowerSchool Start Page menu, click on **Data and Reporting**, then **Custom Reports**.
- 2. Click on the header Administrator to expand the section.
- 3. Select the report called Assessment Reports Summary Results.
 - A. Select Assessment: select the report you wish to run from the dropdown list: all the current NS Provincial Assessments are listed.
 - B. Select Assessment Year: From the dropdown list, select the year in which the assessment you selected was written. You can run only one year at a time. Note that most assessments began in 2012-13.

If you select an assessment from the dropdown list, but select a combination of parameters that have no data, you will get a blank report. E.g. you select Mathematics in Grade 4 and the year 12-13: the province did not administer Mathematics 4 in 12-13 so the resulting report will not display any data.

 Once the parameters have been selected, click **Submit** to generate the report. The results can be viewed on the screen.
