

Physical Distancing

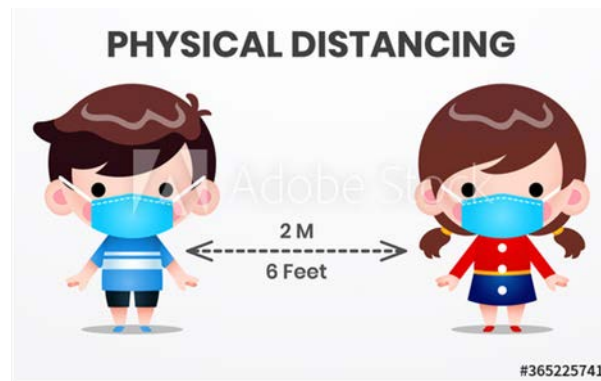
Going to school in September means I will see my friends and teachers.

Some things about school will be different. That is okay. My teacher will tell me what to do.

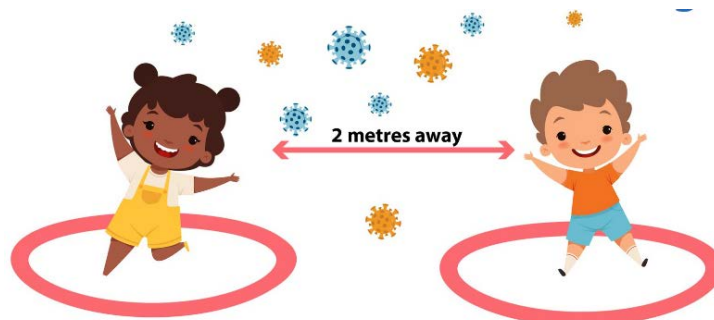
We have some new rules at school because of the COVID-19 virus. A virus is a germ that can make people sick.

One of the new rules at school is **Physical Distancing**.

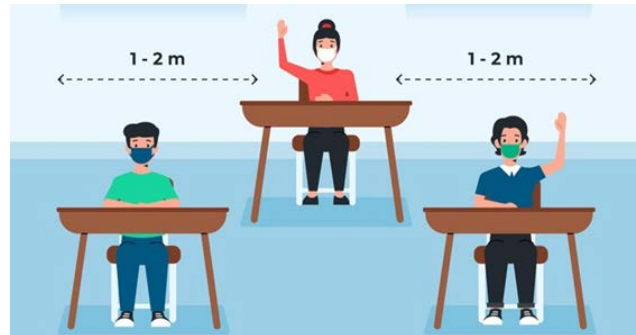
Physical Distancing means I need to stay 2 metres away from other people at school.
