| Internship (High School): a co-operative education placement opportunity for students who have already completed one co-op credit. Through internships, students who have a clear career focus, can continue developing skills related to the career explored in a previous co-op credit. Student interns can receive pay for their work and will receive an additional co-operative education credit. | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| Work Integrated Learning (NSCC): opportunities to apply knowledge and skills outside of the classroom. Can be paid by employer or unpaid. | <input type="checkbox"/> |
| Co-operation Education (NSCC): is an optional elective credit course available after a student has successfully completed all first-year courses included in their IT program. This employer paid, full-time, work placement lasts between 12 to 16 weeks. | <input type="checkbox"/> |
